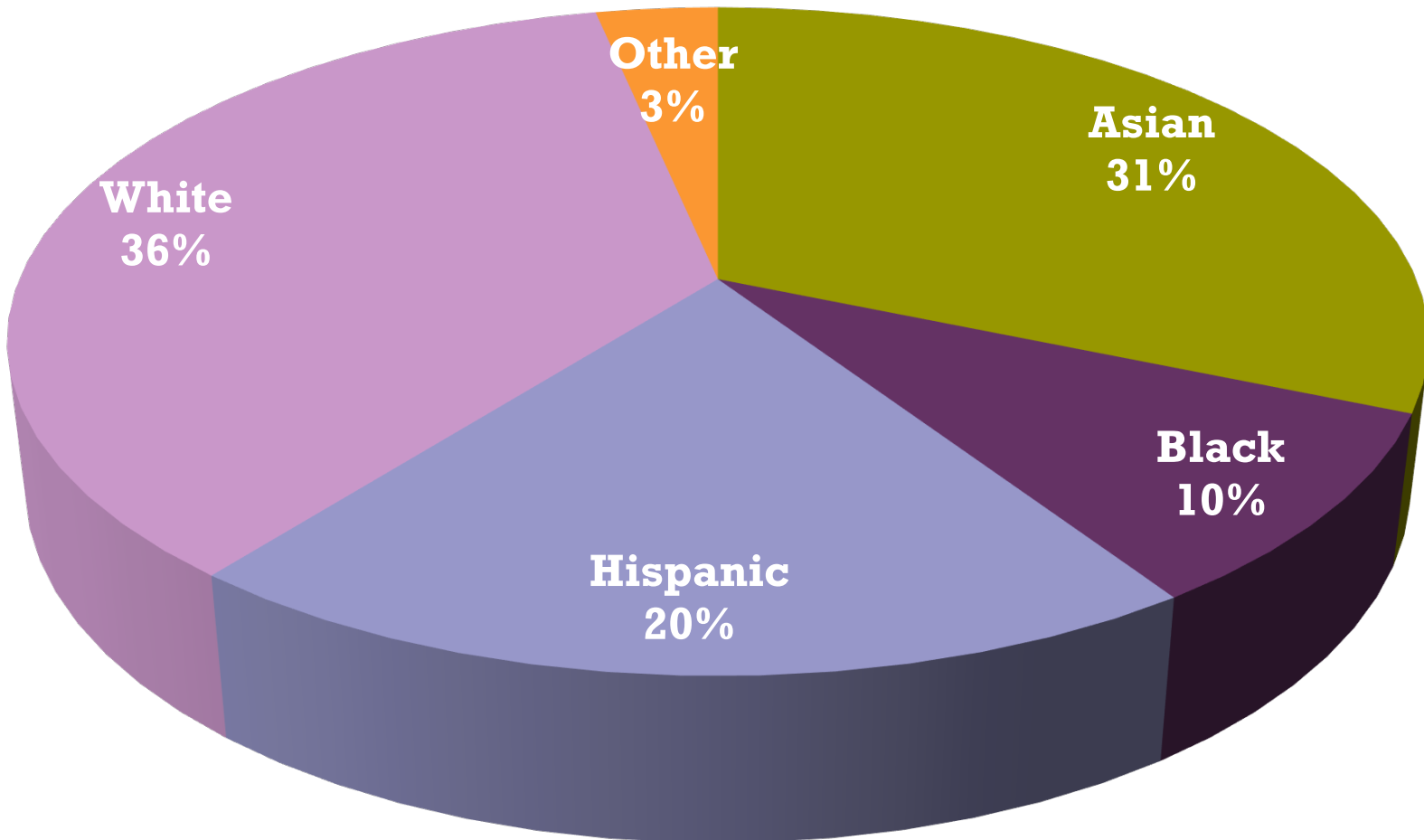

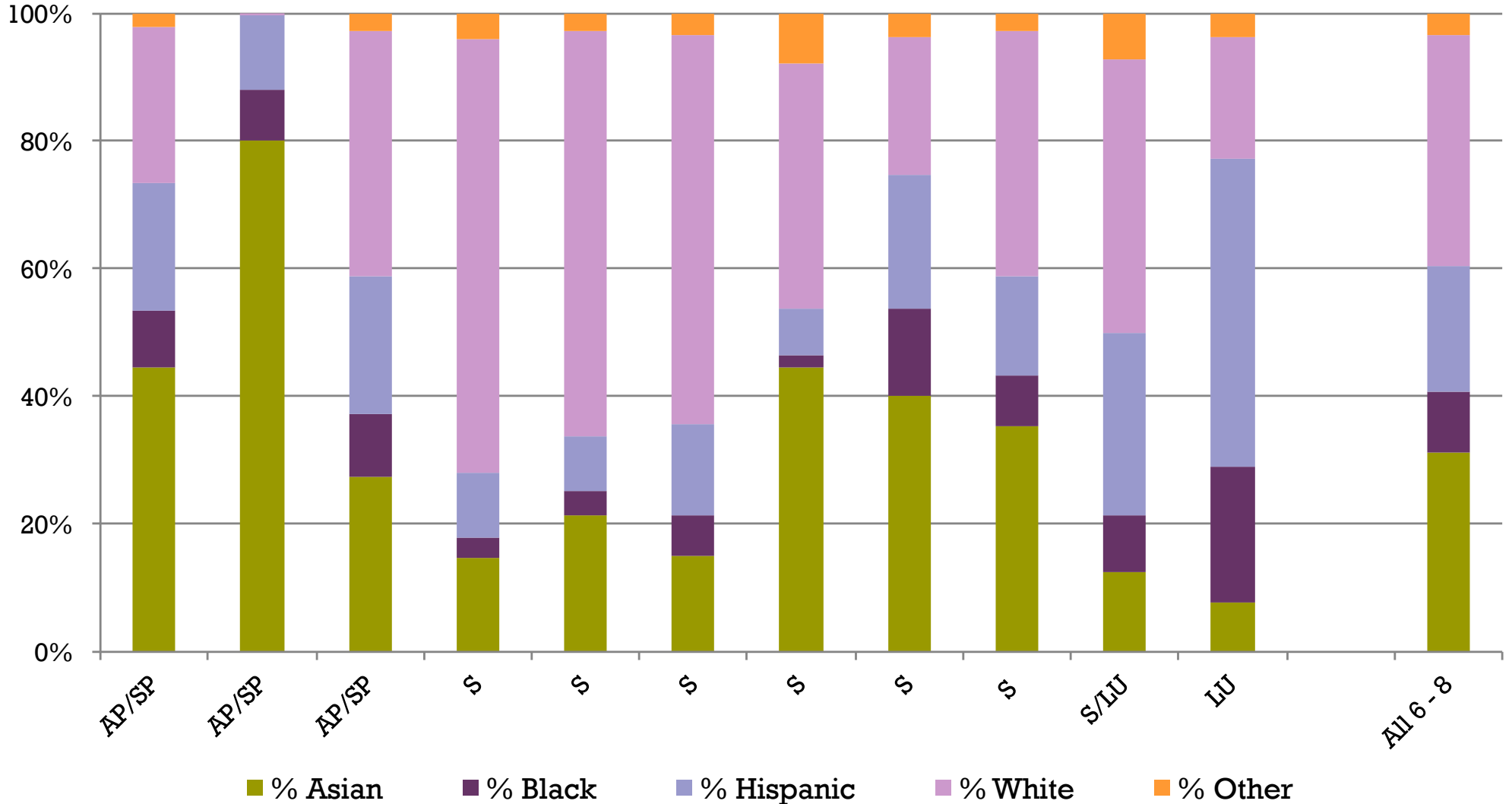

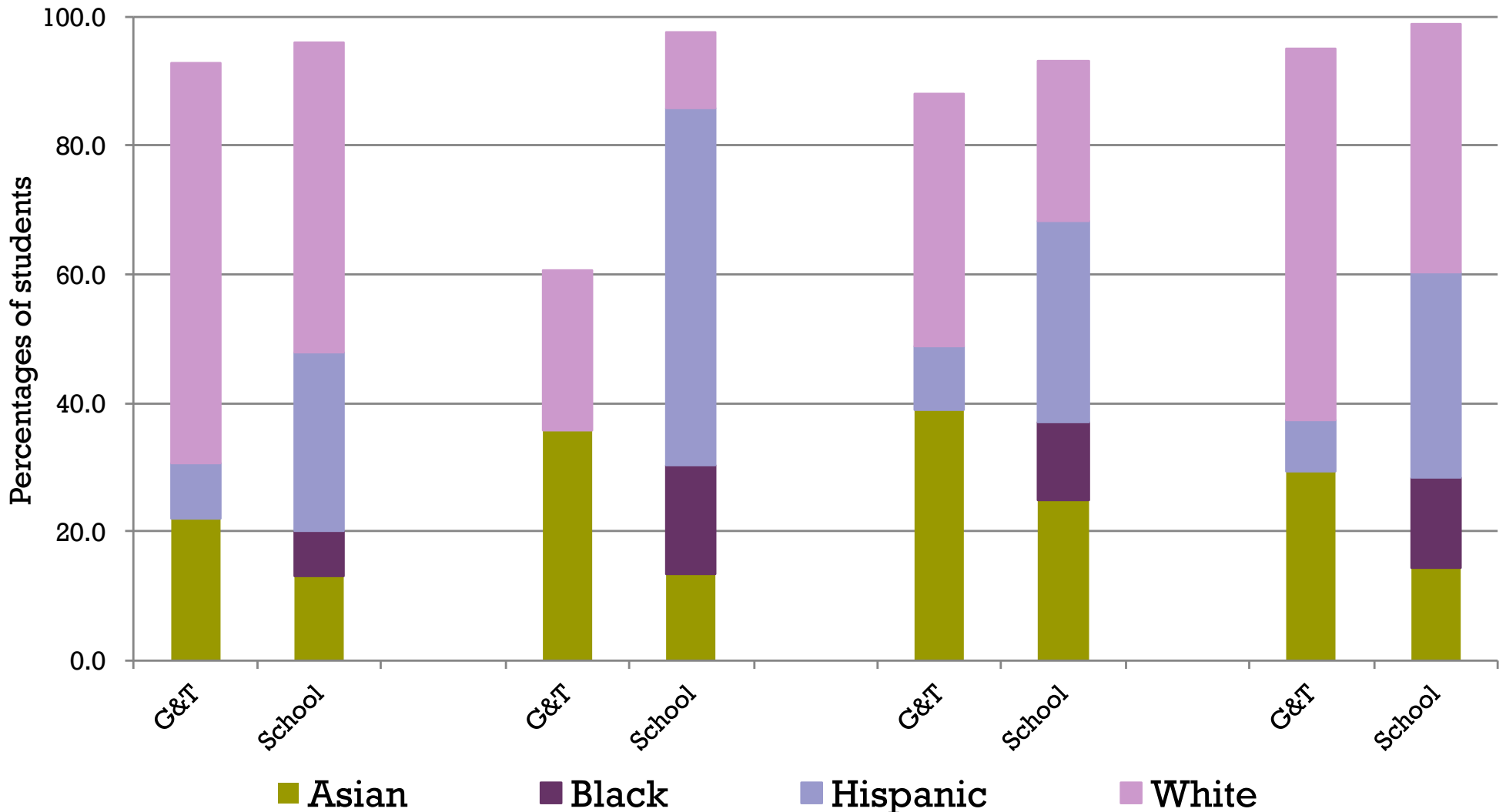


Racial Diversity in Schools



Racial Diversity (%) in G&T vs. School in Subsample of D2 Elementary Schools

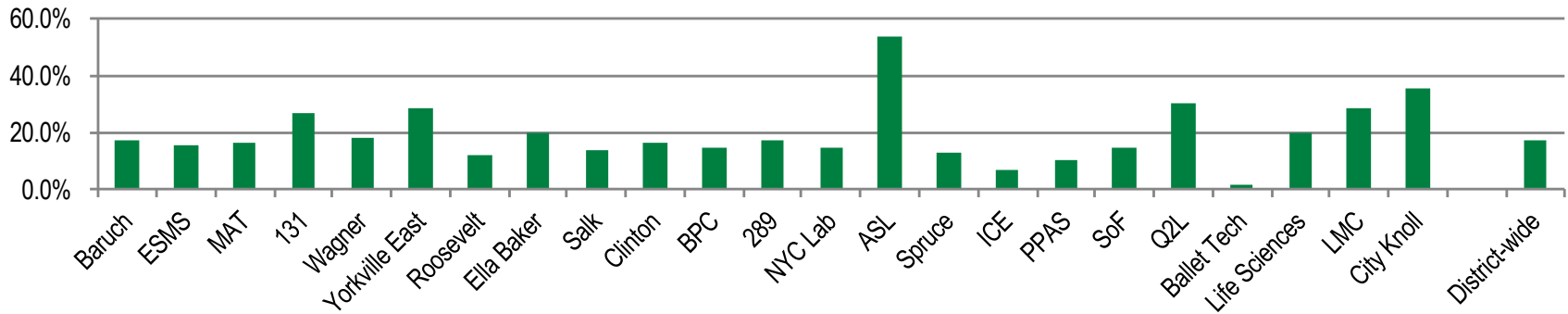

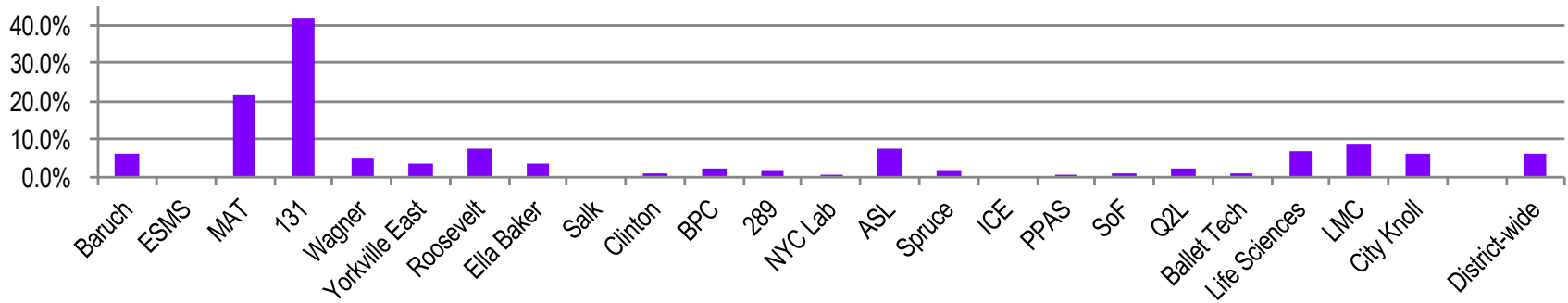

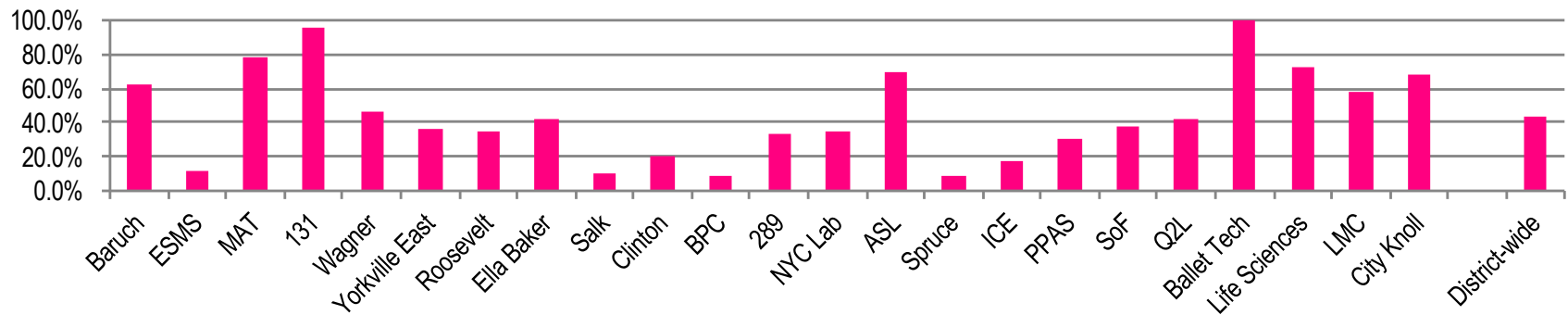
Proportion of Students with Disabilities by School



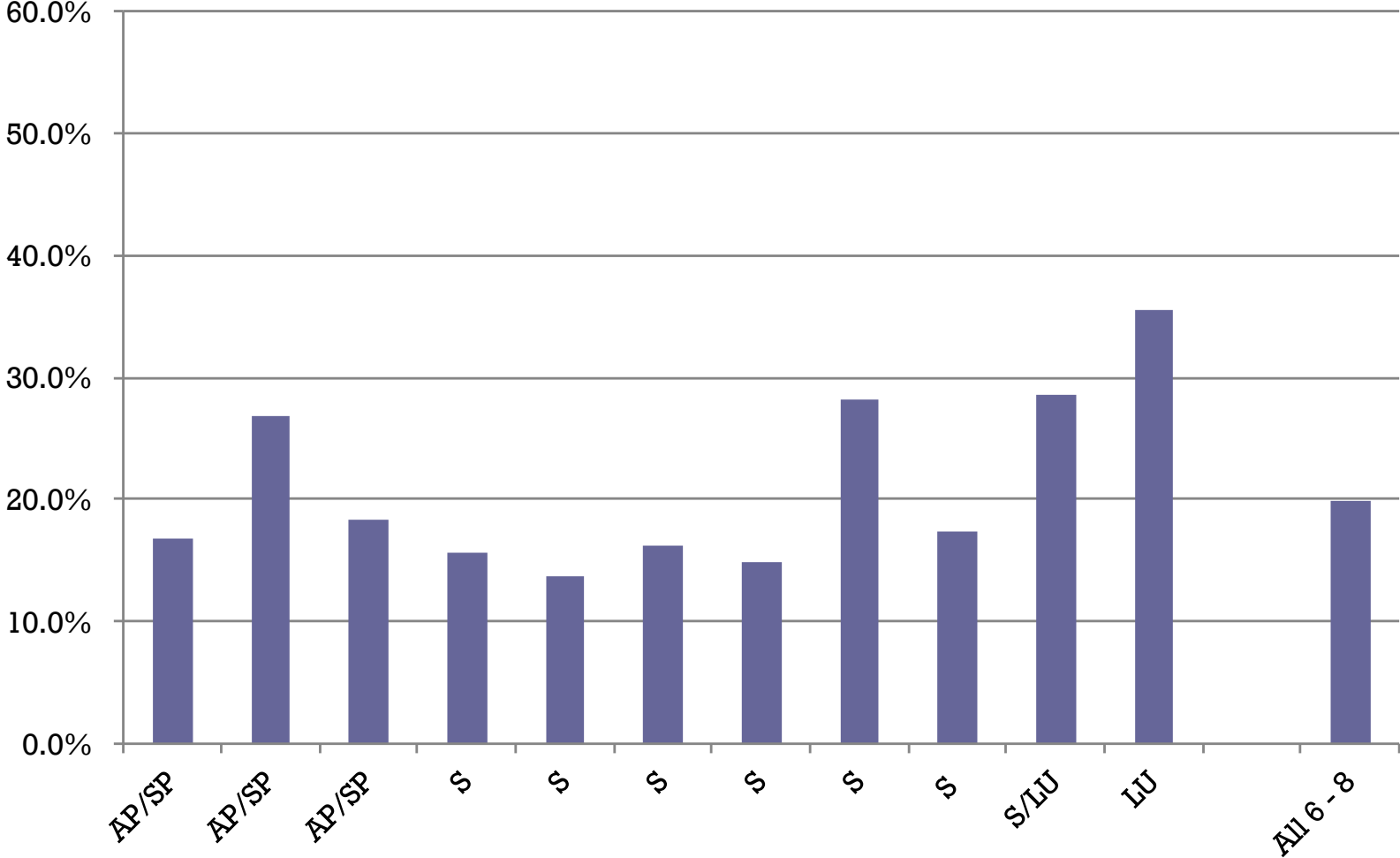
Proportion of English Language Learners by School



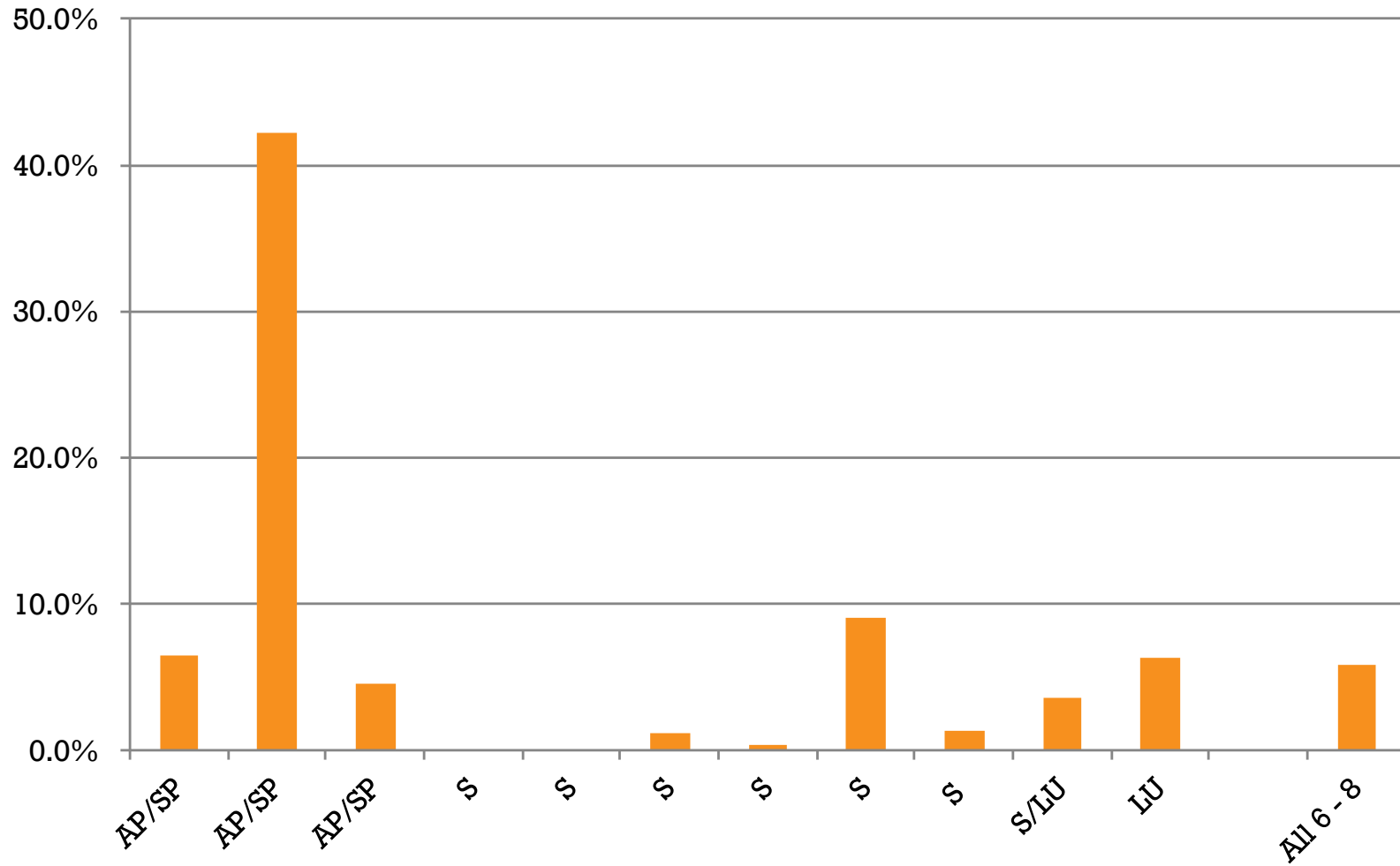
Proportion of Students in Poverty by School



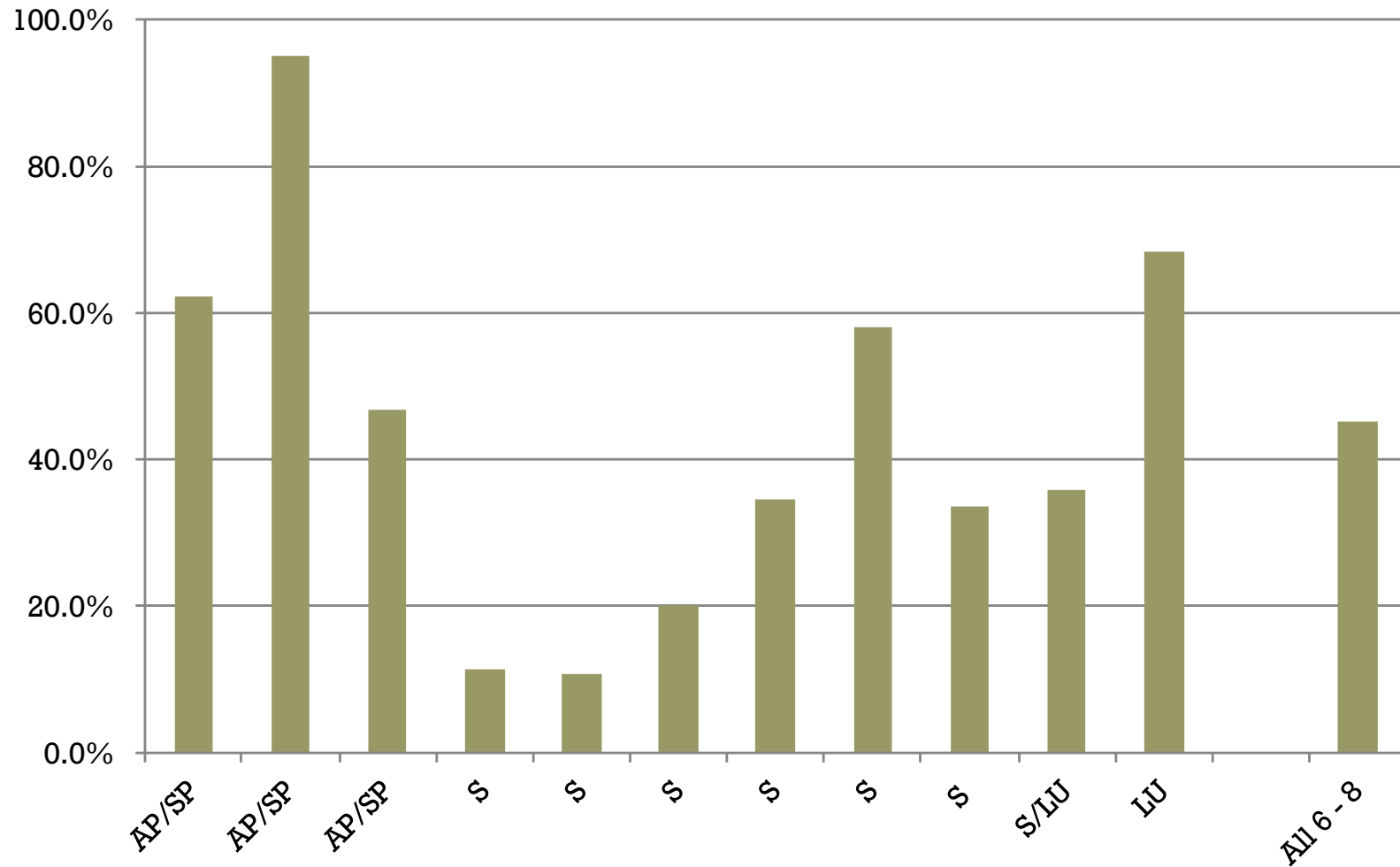
Students with Disabilities by School



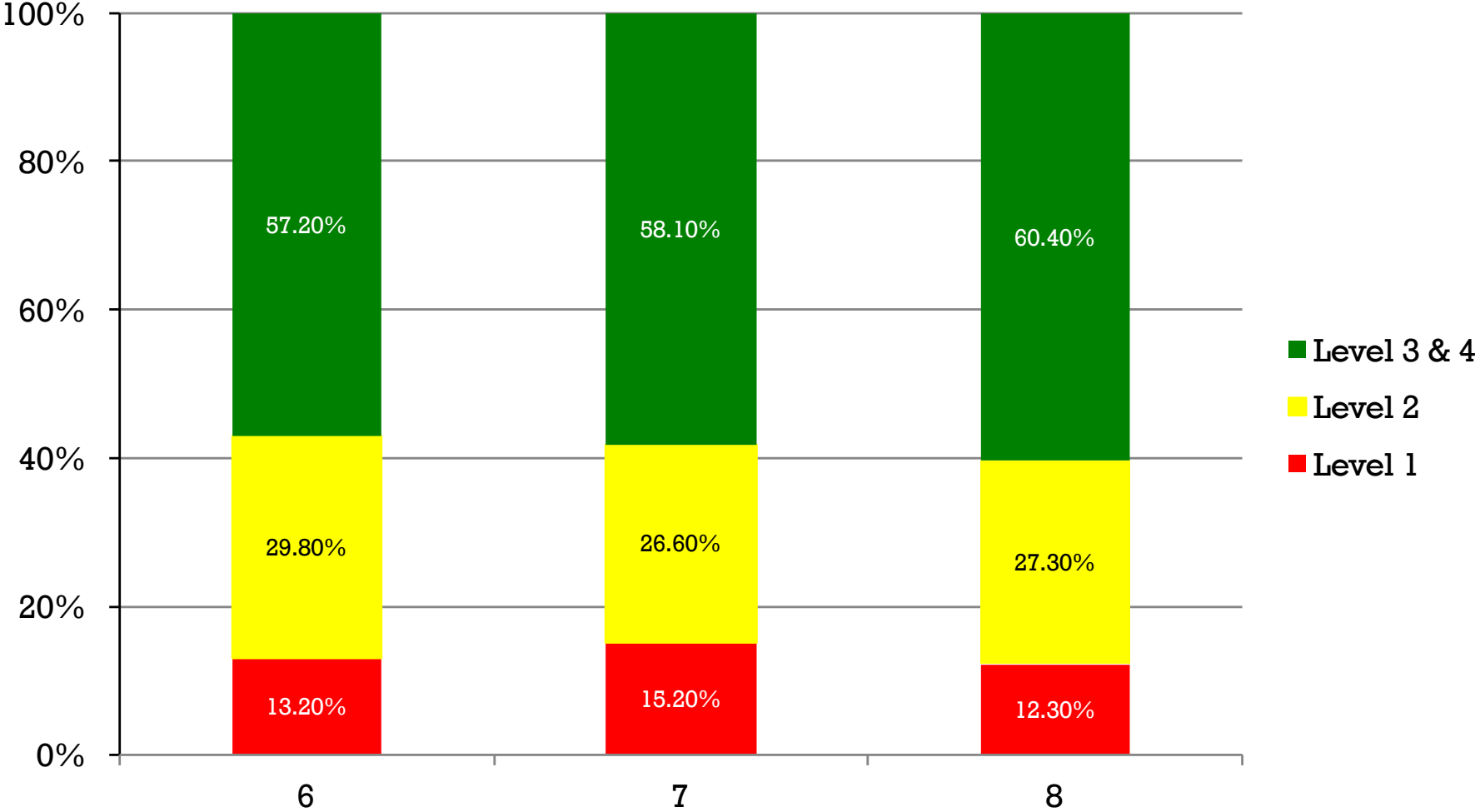
English Language Learners by School



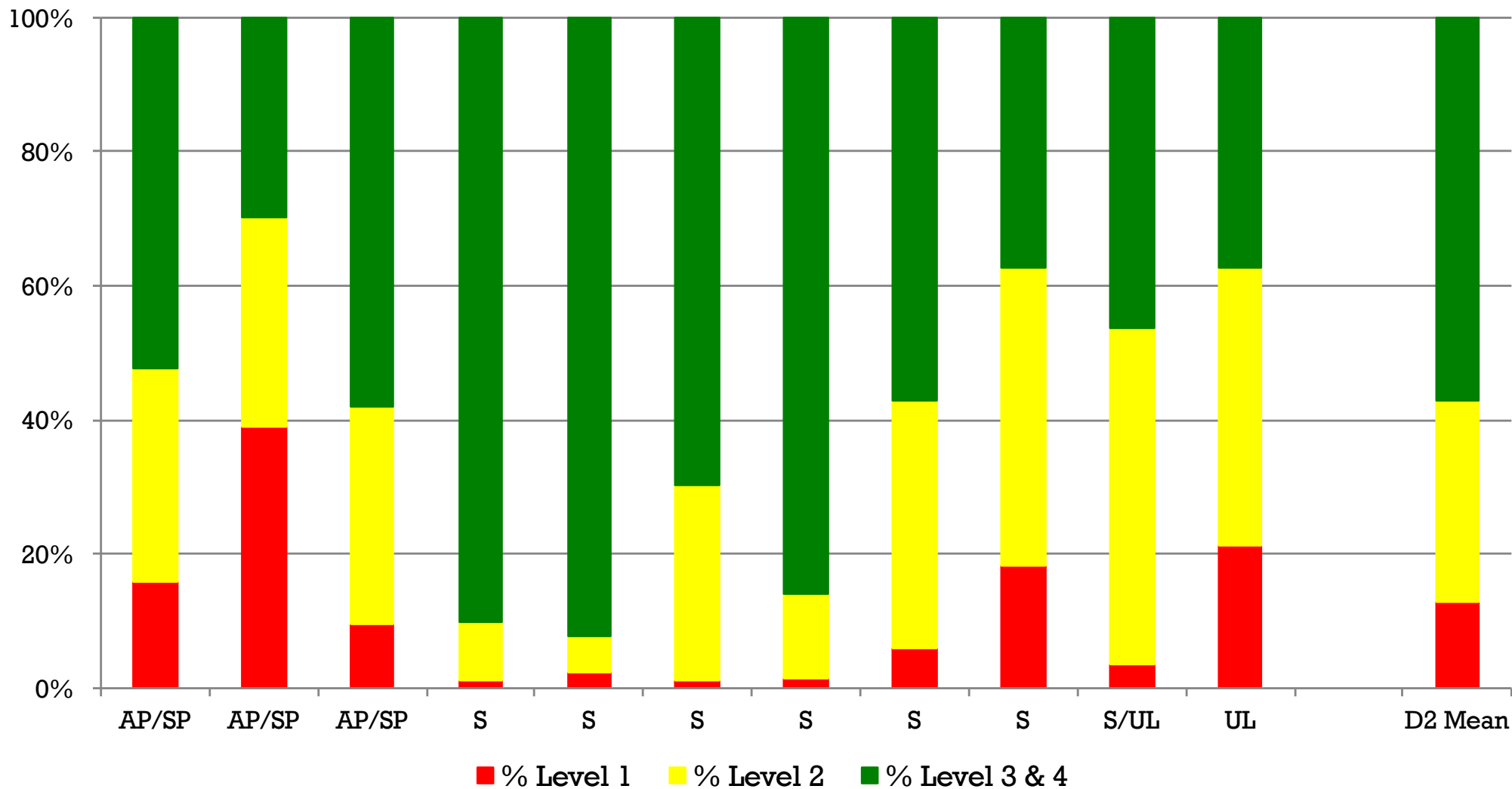

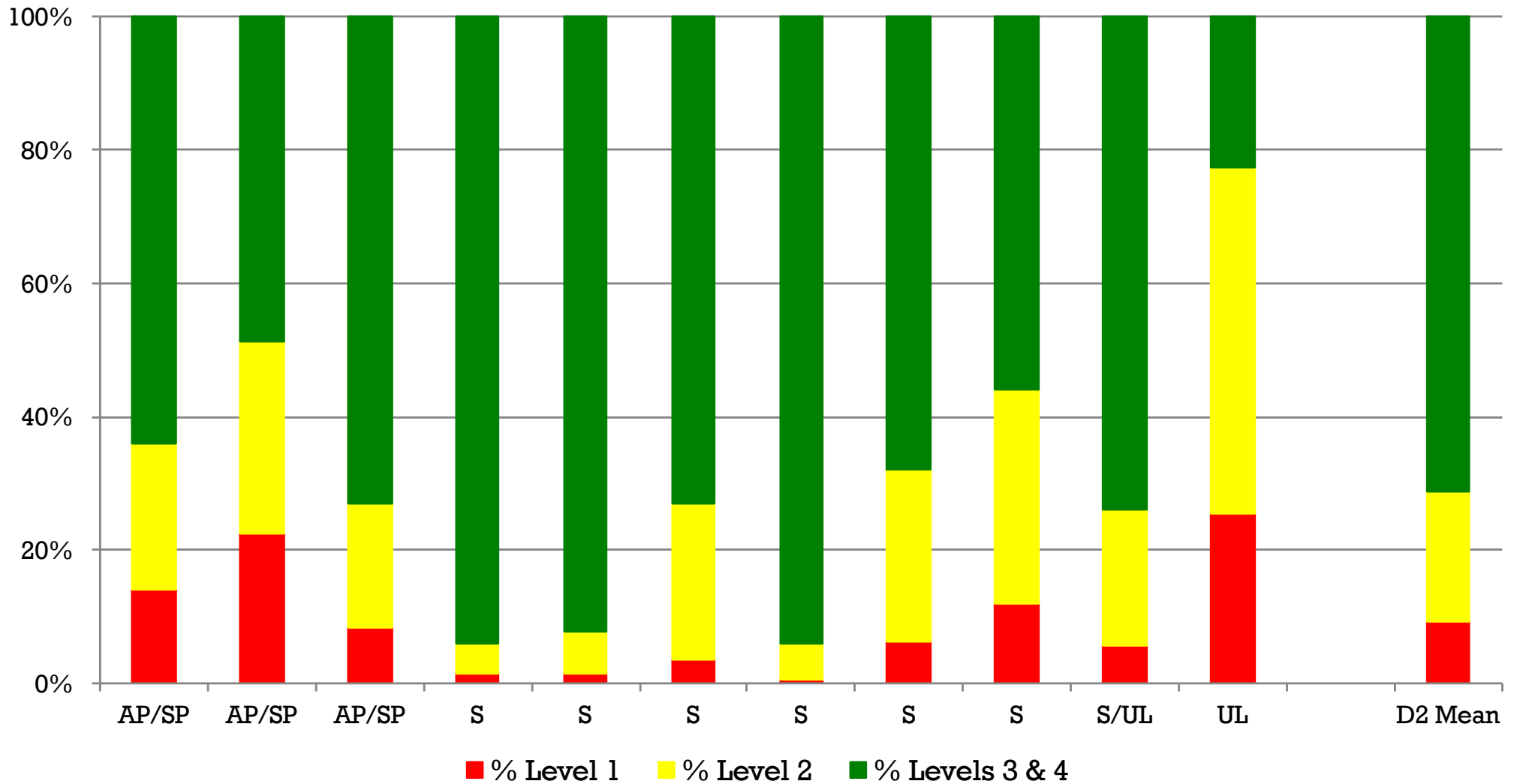
District-wide 2015 ELA Proficiency Levels for 6, 7 and 8 Grades

+ Contributing Factors



- Admissions Methods
 - Use of test scores & other academic performance indicators
 - High demand (# applicants per available seat)
- No Diversity Policy
 - Free market choice system
- Geography & Housing Patterns

+ Multi-Pronged Approach to Integration

- Reform admissions methods
 - Create even playing field
- Develop diversity goals
 - Institute admissions methods to ensure diversity
- Establish a system wide assistance for families
 - Recruit targeted groups of students
 - Provide resources for families
